- You must be approved by the Board before you can volunteer.
- You are responsible for any costs and/or filling out applications by paper or online submission.
- In order for clearances to remain valid from year to year, **volunteers must attend at least one school-sponsored activity throughout the year**, in addition to renewing clearances on a **five-year cycle**.
- All clearances must be dated within one (1) year.

ACT 153 - CHILD PROTECTIVE SERVICES LAW WRITTEN AFFIRMATION FOR VOLUNTEERS

If the volunteer has been a PA resident for 10 years prior to application, and swears by written affirmation that he or she is not disqualified due to a conviction for any crime listed in the Child Protective Services Law (see List of Reportable Offenses), the FBI fingerprint requirement is not required. The Child Abuse and Criminal History clearances are still required.
